"Could This Be You?" Mailers that describe the outreach programs of the SSF and SSF website resources. In 2020, two mailings of approximately 300 letters per mailing to all SSA Chapters (Clubs and Commercial Operators) and all SSA Directors and Governors.

Site Surveys:

2020: 7 Site Surveys conducted (5 repeats): Utah, Texas, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, 2021 Survey requests: Utah, Texas, Oklahoma, Hobbs, Nevada, Albuquerque, Virginia, Illinois

114 Site Surveys in 33 States conducted since 2001.

Common observations include poor launch point organization, poor use of checklists, marginal operations for "convenience" such as intersection takeoffs and downwind landings towards aircraft at the launch point. Slow to clear gliders from the landing area.

Lack of "club management" regarding club pilots and visiting pilots' pilot certificates, currency and proficiency. Inconsistent training technique by club CFIG's.

BC: <u>Site Survey protocol change</u> regarding total confidentiality. E-mail follow up to contact person about specific issues documented and confirm implementation of changes. Lack of implementation will be noted. Repeat visits to sites may be necessary. Budget to be determined.
