Managing the SSA Convention Booth: February 21-25, 2023

SSF Safety Seminar Wednesday evening Feb 22, 6 PM in Atlantis Ballroom. Seating, Stage, AV Requirements have been transmitted to SSA Hobbs office. "WINGS" coordinated with Reno FSDO FAASTeam Manager. SSF Booth fee to SSA for cancelled 2022 convention on hold at SSA HQ. Expenses reimbursement approved at November 1, 2021 Trustees meeting.

Outreach Mailers: "Could This Be You?" Two mailings in 2022. 500 mailers + 500 envelopes to be printed ASAP for 2023 mailing. Mailers describe the outreach programs of the SSF and SSF website resources. In 2022 two mailings of approximately 300 letters per mailing to all SSA Chapters (Clubs and Commercial Operators) and all SSA Directors and Governors.

Site Surveys in 2022: Six. Illinois (2), Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Virginia. Upcoming 2023 Site Surveys to be coordinated with BC. 129 Site Surveys in 33 States conducted since 2001.

Common observations include poor launch point organization, poor use of checklists, unsafe operations for "convenience" such as intersection takeoffs and downwind landings towards aircraft at the launch point. Slow clearing gliders off the landing area. Club CFIG proficiency and experience marginal and training lessons inconsistent. In addition to the SSA wanting "more CFIG's", we need to cultivate "excellent CFIG's." Lack of "club management" regarding club pilots and visiting pilots' pilot certificates, their currency and proficiency.

Renew Flight Review specifically in Glider category.
Winch Launches "gone wrong."

BC: Site Survey protocol has changed regarding absolute confidentiality.

E-mail follow up to contact person about specific issues documented and confirm implementation of changes. Lack of implementation will be noted. Repeat visits to sites necessary.

Get commitments from club leadership for a follow-up Site Survey within 24 months.

BC developing powerpoint script on "Club Management" based on the "Safety Officer Training Guide" and "Safety Management System" (SMS) in development by Tony Condon.

At recent OSTIV board meeting a request was made to extract information from IGC log files, possibly using the latest Machine Learning (ML) techniques. While using ML may be reasonable, I think it would be good to first understand what kinds of safety related behaviors we might extract.

Is thermaling or starting an engine within x ft AGL (whatever x is) the only behavior? Could we identify when a pilot is completing an engine start at some AGL x ft? Can we come up with a list of behaviors that are high risk and then map them to some observable behavior that would be captured in the IGC trace?
